Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to the “Central Institute of Buddhist Studies (CIBS), Choglamsar, Leh- 194104, Jammu and Kashmir” with 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act for the academic session 2019-20-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the CCIM's letter No. 18-12/2019 Sowa Rigpa (CIBS) dated 02.08.2019 in respect of the proposal of Central Institute of Buddhist Studies (CIBS), Choglamsar, Leh- 194104, Jammu and Kashmir to establish Sowa Rigpa teaching Faculty in the college namely “Central Institute of Buddhist Studies (CIBS), Choglamsar, Leh- 194104, Jammu and Kashmir”.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 22-23.07.2019 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. Certain deficiencies have been observed in CCIM recommendation report and therefore, under provisions of the proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 03.09.2019 to present the case.

3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BSRMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to the “Central Institute of Buddhist Studies (CIBS), Choglamsar, Leh- 194104, Jammu and Kashmir” for conducting 15 seats in UG (BSRMS) course for the academic session 2019-20.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Sowa Rigpa Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2017;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2017 (for Sowa Rigpa); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*

6. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.
