i) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D/ equivalent degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table2 of the UGC Regulations 2018.

ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

B. An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D/equivalent degree in the relevant/allied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned /allied /relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/ she has ten years' experience.

1. Sowa Rigpa Menrampa Chugwa/PG qualification in Sowa-Rigpa from a University/Institution recognised by National Commission for Indian System of Medicine or erstwhile Central Council of Indian Medicine under the Act and PhD/equivalent qualification in Sowa Rigpa.

A. i) Master's degree /equivalent with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (minimum Standard and Procedure for the Award of M.Phil /Ph. D Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July, 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinance/Bye-Laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -

iv) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test *NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in Physical Education or Physical Education and Sports or Sports Science in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be. GENERAL INFORMATION


1. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview.
2. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed; or by any other condition that it may deem fit, including conduct of test for shortlisting of candidates.
3. Call letters for test/interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates and no correspondence will be made with applicants who are not short-listed.
4. The CIBS reserves the right to give additional weightage to deserving applicants.
5. The candidates should clearly indicate their specialization as the University will keep the specializations in view while shortlisting the applicants as per its requirement.
6. The number of vacancies indicated are tentative. The University reserves the right to increase /decrease the number of posts, at the time of selection and make appointments accordingly, if more vacancies arise in between the advertisement and Selection Committee meetings. The University reserves the right not to fill any post/s if no suitable candidates are available.
7. The validity of panel of selected/waitlisted candidates will be as per the rules of the CIBS.
8. Candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state the category to which they belong. They must also enclose attested photocopies of valid Caste Certificate / Medical Certificate from the concerned competent authorities as per Govt. orders. The form of caste certificate to be produced by Other Backward Class (OBC) candidates must be in the format as prescribed by the Government of India, clearly specifying that they do not belong to "Creamy Layer" of the OBCs. Further, the caste to which the candidate belongs should be the one included in the Central list of OBC issued by the Government of India. A declaration shall also be submitted by the candidate that he does not belong to the Creamy Layer of OBC. Without valid certificate, the applications will not be considered against the reserved posts. In the absence of valid Caste Certificate, the applicant will be considered under unreserved category.
10. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such a candidate.
11. The Selection Committee may decide its own method of evaluating the performance of the candidates in interview. The University may utilize written/skill test or seminar/colloquium or presentation as a method of selection.
12. The University may offer lower post to the candidate who may have applied for a higher post in case suitable candidates are not available for the advertised post.
13. It would be open to the University to consider the name of the suitable persons who may not have applied, but recommended by the experts in the respective fields.
14. The in-service candidates also should apply through proper channel.
15. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
16. The CIBS being a deemed to be university adopted the UGC Regulations, 2018
17. Qualifications, experience, etc. will be reckoned as on the last date for receipt of filled-in applications. Clear photocopies of all important certificates must be attached with the application.
18. Incomplete applications in any respect shall not be considered at all.
19. No interim queries regarding interview/ selection will be entertained.
20. In case of any disputes/suits or legal proceedings against the University, the Jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Leh, Ladakh which is the Headquarter of the University.

The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows:

Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

- i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor - 5Points

- ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 - 10Points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 - 15Points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 - 20Points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 - 25Points
- vi) Paper with impact factor >10 - 30Points
- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- There search score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
