10. Invitation of Application:

10.1. The University Admission Committee shall issue a notification for admission to various UG/PG Programmes for all Odd Semesters in the month of March every year.


10.2. Admissions shall be purely based on merit-cum-category roster as per the norms of Government of India issued from time to time.

10.3. Academic Year normally commences on the first of March ever year. The exact date for commencement of Academic Year shall be decided by the University.

11. Eligibility


The eligibility to seek admission in UG/PG. Programme shall be as under:

14.1. For a UG Programme, the candidate shall have passed 10+2 (Uttar Madhyama –II) with Bhoti and English / Hindi or any other 10+2 equivalent qualifications of other streams recognized by the State Government or Central Government educational boards.

- 14.2. For the PG Programme, a candidate must have passed 3 years/6 Semesters or 4 year/ 8 Semesters UG Programme recognized by any State/Central Government educational institutions.
- 14.3. For foreign candidates with any other equivalent qualification approved by the University or the Central Government.
- 14.4. An entrance test shall be conducted by the admission committee constituted by the institute headed by Dean, Students' Welfare/Convener, Admission Committee.
- 14.5. Direct admission by any means other than above specified shall not be approved.
- 14.6. The examination department shall maintain the records of every fresh candidate as per the recommendation and selection by the said committee.
- 14.7. The eligibility to seek admission in B.S.R.M.S Program shall strictly follow the notification of NCISM, published in the Official Gazette, dated 29 Sept 2017 and 16 Nov 2022.
- 14.8. Admission fees: Rs.50 per form.
